**Topic:** COVID Impacts on Ozone in Atlanta

In 2020, Atlanta met the ozone standard for the first time in 40 years!! This presentation will discuss ozone trends in Atlanta, provide a conceptual description of ozone formation in Atlanta, and discuss the impact of COVID on air emission and ozone concentrations in 2020. Specifically, ground-level and satellite air quality measurements will be compared for pre-COVID and post-COVID conditions. Also, the impact of COVID on freeway volumes, travel times, airport operation, and power plant emissions will be discussed. Finally, next steps for redesignating Atlanta back to attainment will be presented.
