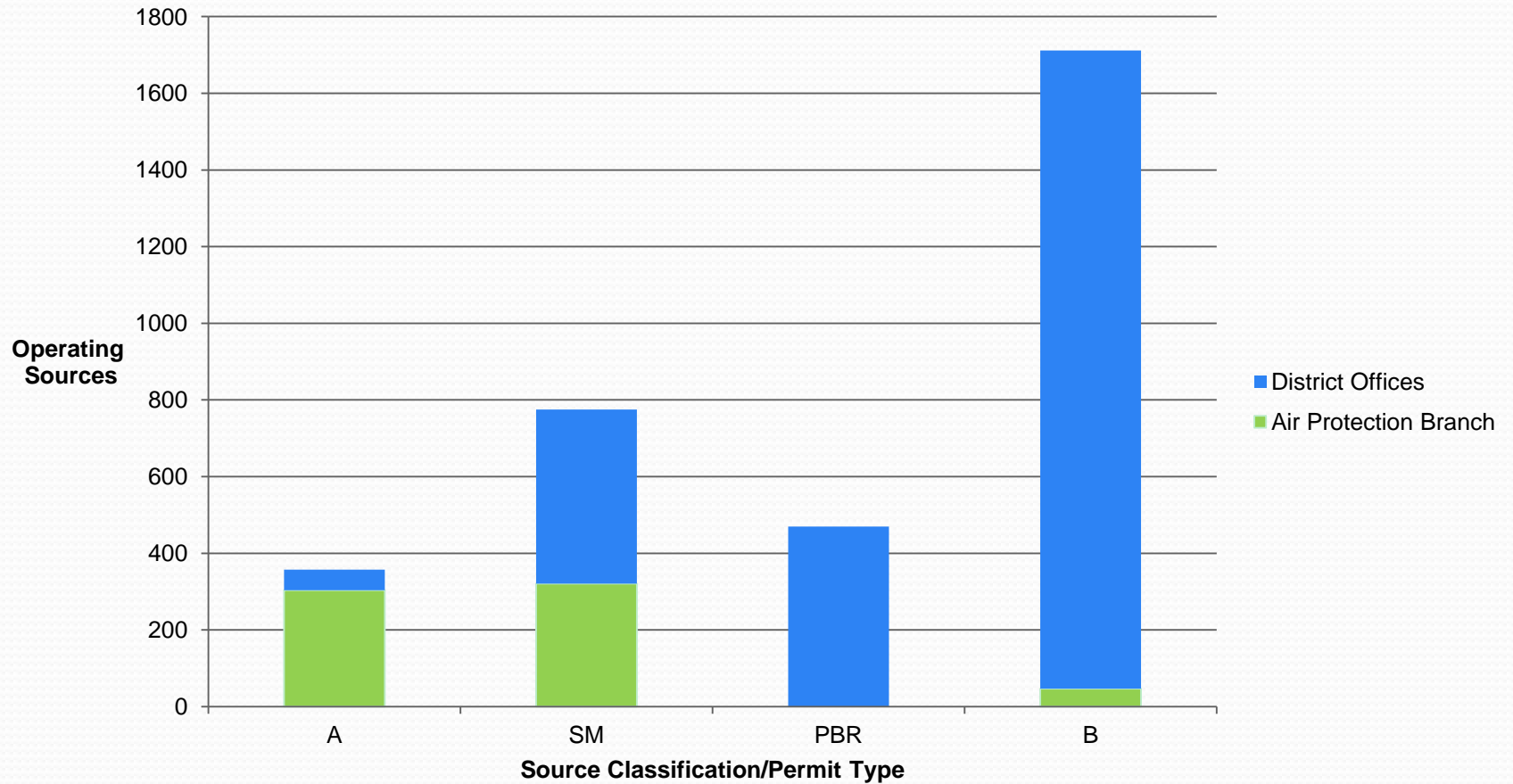
Districts and Locations:

- All statewide sources, permit-by-rule sources, most true minor or “B” sources
- Some Title V sources for Cartersville and Coastal
- Most complaint investigations
- Open burning

2011 Permit Fee Project

- 57 NOVs issued for failure to pay permit fees
- All NOVs have been resolved or addressed
 - Four Administrative Orders issued
 - One Consent Order executed
 - About \$154,000 collected as a result of project
 - 11 Permits revoked by Director for failure to pay Permit Fees
 - Two fee waivers granted to small businesses

Area Source Boiler Rule

- 40 CFR Part 63 Subpart JJJJJJ (6J)
- Amendments proposed December 23, 2011, final rule went to OMB on May 21, 2012, *finalized August 2012???*

Major Source Boiler MACT

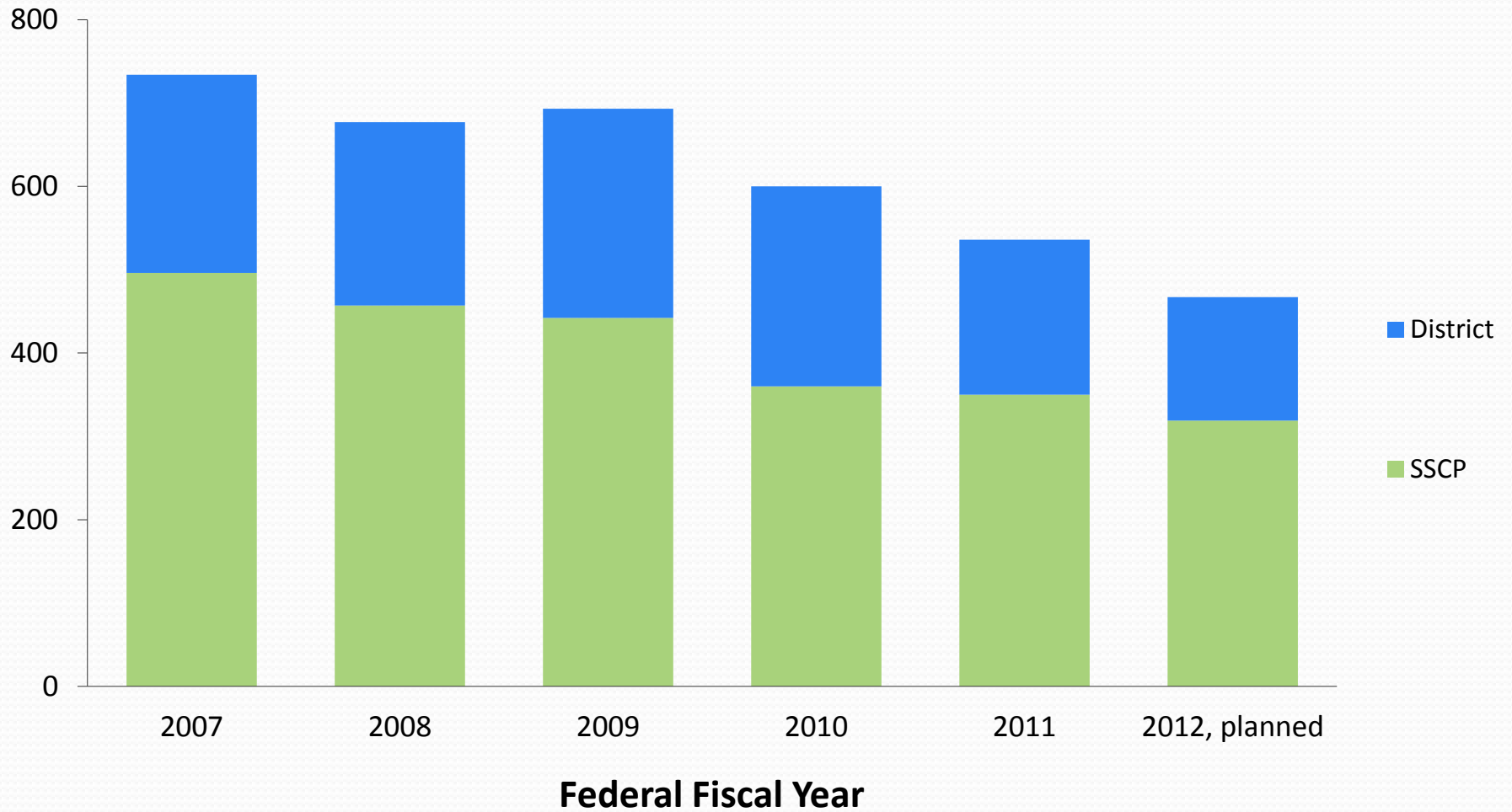
- 40 CFR Part 63 Subpart DDDDD
- May 18, 2011 - EPA delayed the effective date of the Boiler MACT.
- January 9, 2012 - The U.S. District Court for the DC Circuit vacated EPA's delay (May 18, 2011 notice)
- February 7, 2012 – EPA issued a “no action assurance” letter concerning notification deadlines for Subpart DDDD

Reciprocating Internal Combustion Engines (RICE) MACT

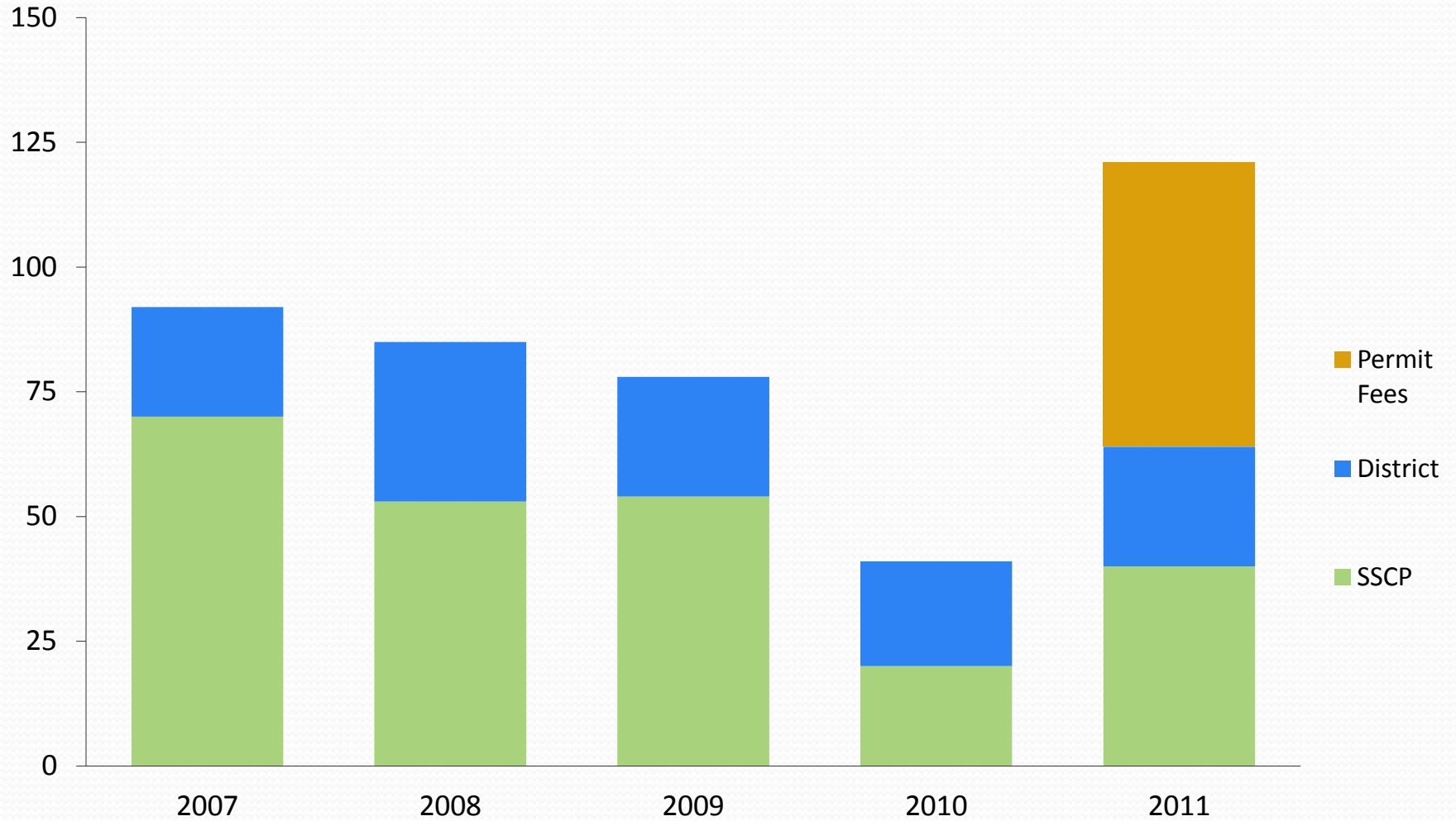
- 40 CFR Part 63 Subpart ZZZZ
 - Amended multiple times
 - Proposed amendment signed on 5/22/12
 - Major source and area sources are covered
- Some sources that are exempt from permitting are subject to notification requirements
- Equipment may also be subject to Spark Ignition NSPS or Compression Ignition NSPS

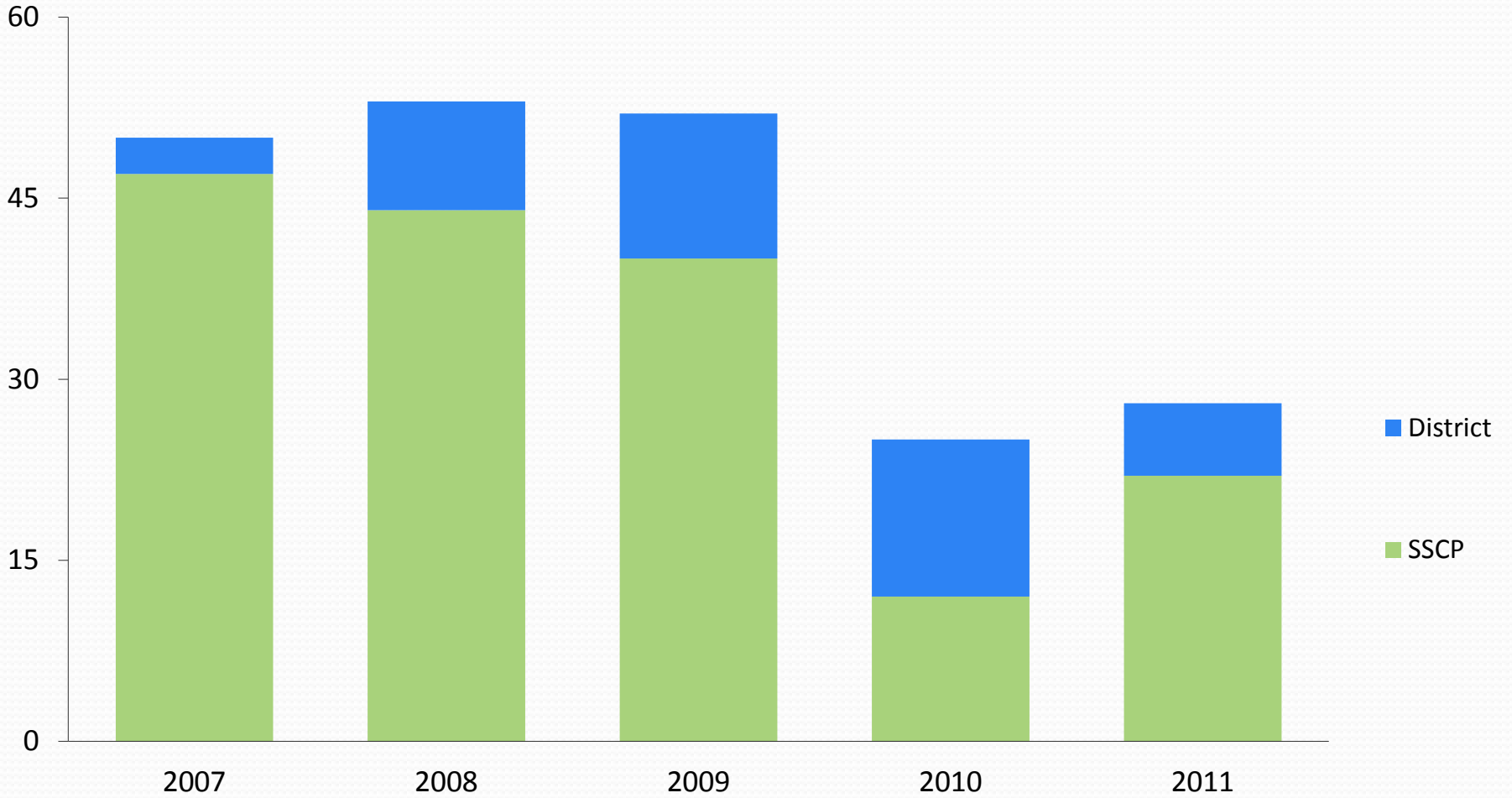
Inspections Completed



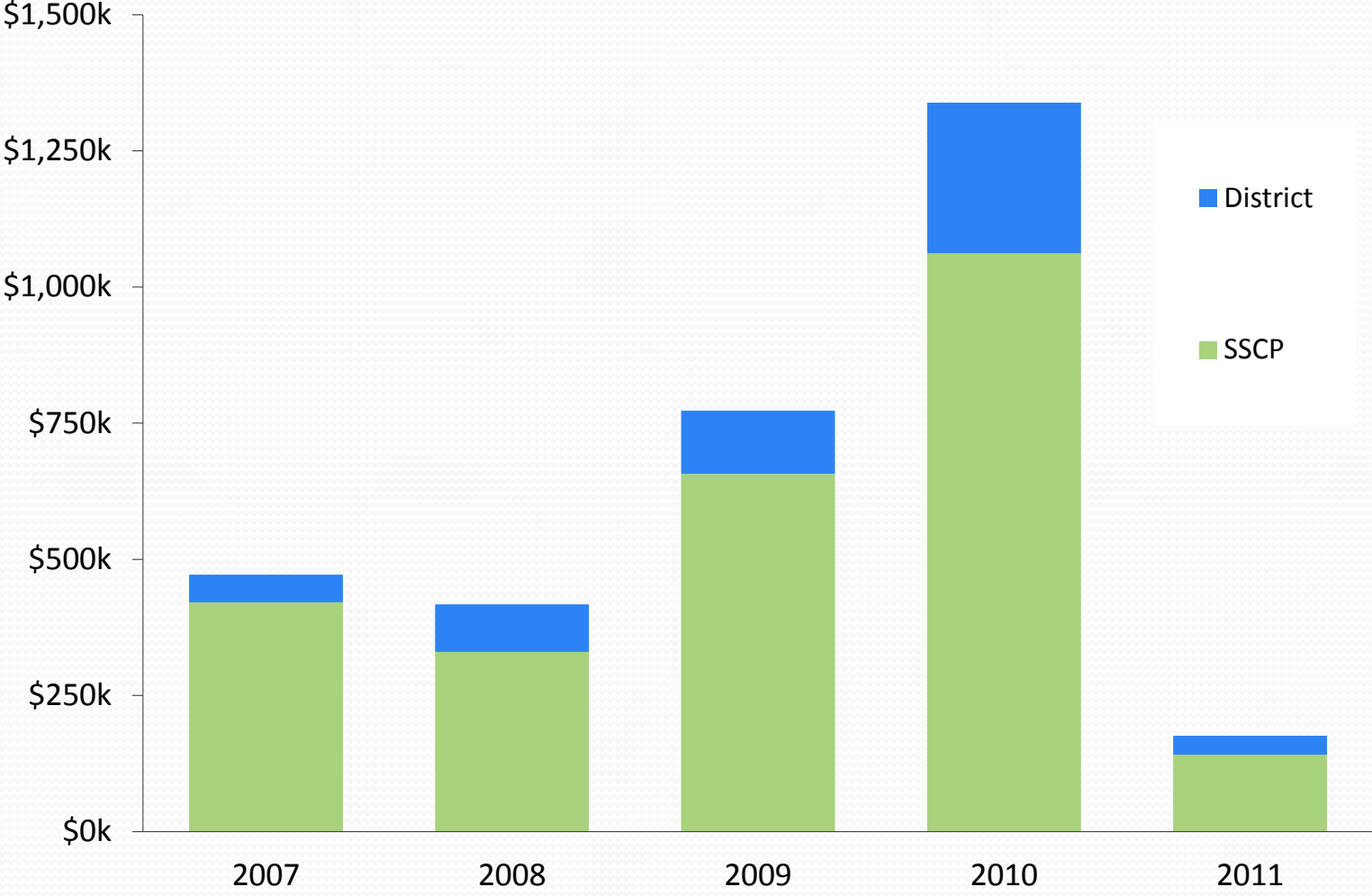
Notices of Violations Issued
